Morning Drop Off

In the morning you as a parent/carer are responsible for your child until 8.40am when the school opens for a soft start and

pupils may enter the school. The staff then take over responsibility for supervising your child. If your child attends any morning clubs, it is your responsibility to hand your child over to the school personally and not to drop them outside the school gates, in case there is an issue with the club.

Under no circumstances should a child be on their own in the playground before 8.40am as the school is not responsible for supervising them.

Walking home on your own

Pupils in year 6 have permission to walk home by themselves if the parents complete a permission slip at the office. If they are walking to school on their own, they must not arrive before 8.40am at which time they are then supervised.

After school, all parents must be on time to pick up their children at 3.15pm/3.20pm. If you are running late, ring the office and advise them immediately so that your child is then brought to the office. We want all of our pupils to be safe and not take any unnecessary risks.

Reminder: We are a no nut school – Please DO NOT bring any nut products onto school site even as an after school snack.

Reminder: If your child has an assembly, please attend this on time. We will not allow anyone into the assembly 10 minutes after the arrival time allocated to parents. This causes a huge disruption to the children's performance and to the office staff. Please ensure you arrive on time or you will not be allowed entry.

Uniform

We have a strict uniform policy which is available on the school website. Please ensure that you are following this. All hijabs and head gear need to be black, white, grey or red with no accessories attached.
